Readings:

Day 98 | Monday | May 18 | [Acts 9](#) - Saul persecutes the Way and sees Jesus and is blinded; Ananias speaks to Jesus and is reluctant to encounter Saul; Saul is healed, preaches, comes to Jerusalem, church leaders afraid of him but finally accept him; Peter continues his ministry.

Day 99 | Tuesday | May 19 | [Acts 10](#) - Peter while praying is instructed by God that all food is good and righteous; He meets Cornelius; Peter proclaims the message of God to the Gentiles (non-Jewish people) and they receive the power of God through the Holy Spirit; they are baptized.

Day 100 | Wednesday | May 20 | [Acts 11](#) – Peter’s report to the Church leaders in Jerusalem; the Church in Antioch – place where believers are called Christians; prophets predict severe famine; first world hunger appeal for funds.

Day 101 | Thursday | May 21 | [Acts 12](#) - King Herod kills James and imprisons Peter; Angel breaks out Peter; Herod dies; missionary tour...

Day 102 | Friday | May 22 | [Acts 13](#) - Barnabas and Saul are commissioned on a missionary journey for the spreading of the Gospel; they preach on Cyprus; Saul becomes Paul; Paul proclaims to Jews and Gentiles alike by hearing the salvation history – Gentiles rejoice for they are included in this faith.
